4.1 Finance

Ms. Byerrum reported on the January Financials. Administrative and legal costs have been less than what was budgeted. The PERS Actuarial Report indicates the Fire Department's unfunded liability is \$17,000 for fiscal year 2016/2017.

4.2 Fire Chief's Report

Chief Thompson reported the Department responded to 166 calls for assistance during February. There were three significant alarms for the month. One involved a fire burning in the side yard of a single family residence. The second alarm occurred in a parking lot causing damage to four vehicles and the metal carport. Both fires resulted in traffic congestion with the public rushing to the vicinity to look at the fires. An engineer is out on workers compensation after breaking his collar bone. A temporary part time firefighter from the paid call firefighter ranks has been hired to cover his position until his return.

Seven paid call firefighters participated in the month of February.
